Resource Preparation

Blue Card

Canson Keay Colour (Royal Blue) 250 gsm A3 \$0.95/sheet The Art Shop
3 flag bases (140 x 280) can be cut from an A3 sheet (420 x 288)

Red Paper

Vivaldi (Red #35) 120 gsm A4 \$0.35/sheet The Art Shop
Print red element template (Red Elements.pdf) and cut pages into three parts, as indicated (3 sets of elements are printed per A4 page).

White Paper

Bond copy paper 80 gsm A4 ~\$6.00/ream
Print white element template (White Elements.pdf) and cut pages in half (2 sets of elements are printed per A4 page).

Paper Glue

UHU *stic* Glue Stick 8.2g \$9.99 (6 pack) The Art Shop
The smaller glue sticks (specified) are much easier for children to use to get a neat result than the larger items.
