
Five-ring Mat

This is really a series of Turk's Head knots.
Make it with cord about 5 mm thick.




4 Still going anti-clockwise, go over the next loop,


then under.




1 Start with a loop.

2 Using end B, make another loop under the first. Hold both loops in position.






3 Take end B over the top cord, then under the second loop. It's all a bit wobbly still, so hold it carefully.




5 Then over and under again.
Now it should all hold together a bit better.



6 Even out the loops, then take the end right through the knot again

doing exactly the same unders and overs.



7 Follow the second cord through again and you have a three-lead mat.

8 Tighten the loops by easing the cord through. Then cut ends so they are neatly hidden on the underside of the mat, and either sew or glue them in place.
